- Conduct Personal Affairs seminars for members.

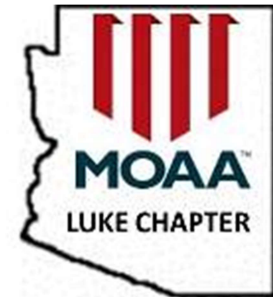
## Social
